In March of 2015, Chief Taft of the Village of Kingston Police Department submitted a grant request to ComEd asking for funding to purchase a Kustom Signals Pro Laser 4 speed detection unit to enforce the speed limit with in the Village of Kingston and the school zone located around the Kingston Grade School, which is located on a State Highway. It will also be used to enforce the speed limit around the Kingston Township Park where Football, Baseball and soccer league games are held. In August 2015 Chief Taft received notice that the grant had been awarded to the Kingston Police Department.
