There are five (5) open positions:

OFFICE OF VILLAGE TRUSTEE – FOUR YEAR TERM

Number to be voted: Three (3) Full Term – Four (4) Years

OFFICE OF VILLAGE TRUSTEE – TWO YEAR TERM

Number to be voted: One (1) Unexpired Term – Two (2) Years

OFFICE OF VILLAGE PRESIDENT – TWO YEAR TERM

Number to be voted: One (1) Unexpired Term – Two (2) Years

Please note the position being sought on your election materials being filed.

Candidates must live in the Village for one (1) full year, be a registered voter, and satisfy other eligibility requirements.

Completed nomination papers will be accepted at Village Hall (101 East Railroad Street), from November 16, 2026 to November 23, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (during normal business hours), and from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on November 23, 2026.

Candidates need to file the following documents with the Village Clerk:

- Statement of Candidacy
- Statement of Economic Interest Receipt
- Petitions
- Loyalty Oath (optional)
